CONTEXT :

The Department of Clinical Sciences of Companion Animals and Equids of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Liège offers a full time academic position. This position involves teaching, research and academic service (participation to school and department committees).

This position is available from the academic year 2010-2011 on, in the field of veterinary clinical oncology.

TASKS :

The successful candidate will be responsible for the following tasks:

Teaching :

Responsibility of theoretical, practical and clinical teaching in second cycle , in Advanced Master, and in third cycle (master degree) related to veterinary clinical oncology. The aim of this teaching is the diagnosis and management of diseases of tumoral origin.

The initial mission includes the following courses, available in the Department of Clinical Sciences.

- Clinical oncology of domestic animals, 2GMV, 12h TS
- Companion animals clinical module clinique, partim oncology, 2GMV, 2h CL
- Internal Medicine of Companion Animals, partim oncology, 3GMV, 20% CL
- Clinical oncology of Companion animals, MC MVS Companion Animals, 3weeks CL

Research :

The successful candidate must have demonstrated potential to initiate and develop, extramurally funded original and innovant reseach programmes and promote studies and PhD programmes in the field of oncology. Areas of comparative research in veterinary oncology are numerous and various : pathology, genetics, epidemiology, ecotoxicology,

Services :

- Participation to the clinical duties (Clinique vétérinaire universitaire) (the clinic is open 24h/24 and 365 days/year) for activities related to oncology in Companion Animals and Equids
- Development of a specialized medical service, allowing possible training of European specialists in oncology.
- Contribution to continuing education in the field of national and international veterinary oncology.
- Participation to changes needed in the legislation related to therapy (chemotherapy, radiotherapy)

PROFILE :

The candidate will hold both a DVM degree (or an academic grade judged equivalent) and a PhD. He or she should be a member of one of the EBVS (European Board of Veterinary Specialisation)-recognized boards. Ideally, the candidate should be a diplomate of the ECIM (European College of Internal Medicine) - companion animals - specialty oncology, or fulfill the conditions to get the diploma within 3 years after nomination.

If the candidate has carried out a long-term (more than 6 months) research assignment in an institution outside French-speaking Belgium, this would constitute a major advantage in terms of career development.

The successful candidate will either:

- be appointed for a fixed term. This term (or cumulative period of terms) shall not exceed five years, after which a permanent appointment may be envisaged;
- or will be appointed on a permanent contract.

Candidates are requested to send, by recorded delivery:

- their application consisting of two copies of their complete *curriculum vitae*;
- an example of their publications
